

# Lawn Mower Maintenance Log

Use this log to keep equipment maintenance records for the year. Some manufacturers may recommend different time intervals for maintaining parts and equipment. Consult your manufacturer's operating manual to confirm specific maintenance recommendations.

**Daily Maintenance Before Mowing**

- Clean Mower Deck and Check Under Hood for Debris
- Check Air Filter
- Clean Radiator
- Check Belt Adjustments (if not self-adjusting)
- Grease Spindle Assembly (if not maintenance-free)
- Clean Transmission and Engine Coolers
- Check Tires for Damage, Air Pressure

**Every 25 Hours of Service**

- Clean and Lubricate Throttle, Choke and Gears.....
- Check Battery Connection and Fluid Levels.....
- Sharpen and Balance Blades.....
- Check Safety Switches and Chute.....

**Every 50 Hours of Service**

- Change Engine Oil and Filter.....
- Inspect/Change Spark Plugs.....

DATE/INITIALS


**Every 100 Hours of Service**

- Replace Air Filter.....
- Sharpen/Replace Blades.....
- Inspect Spark Plugs.....
- Clean Carburetor.....
- Check Tires.....
- Replace Fuel Filter.....

**Every 250 Hours of Service**

- Change Spark Plugs.....
- Change Transmission Oil and Filter.....

DATE/INITIALS


**Yearly/Before Storing for the Season**

- Clean Battery Terminals
- Flush the Radiator
- Clean Engine Cooling Fans
- Lubricate Wheel Rims/Axles
- Clean Up Old Grease and Repack Bearings
- Remove Engine Housing and Clean Grass and Dirt
- Add Fuel Stabilizer

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
