

This narrow focus excludes numerous other factors that can inhibit mental fitness such as fatigue, stress, distraction, prescription drugs and over-the-counter medications. Traditional testing requires physical samples and is time consuming, leaving a potentially impaired worker onsite. Aware4Duty produces results in under one minute.
